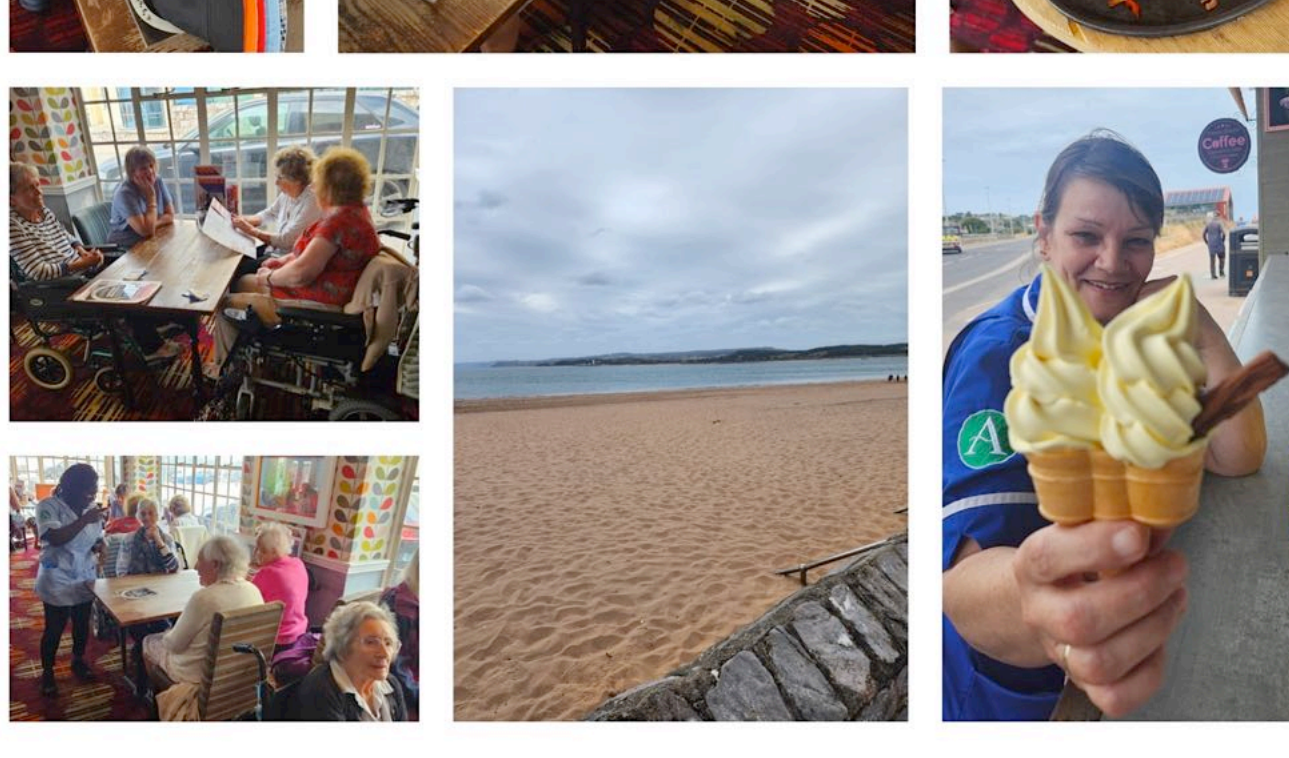


Trip To Exmouth Beach

D-Day 80th Anniversary Show

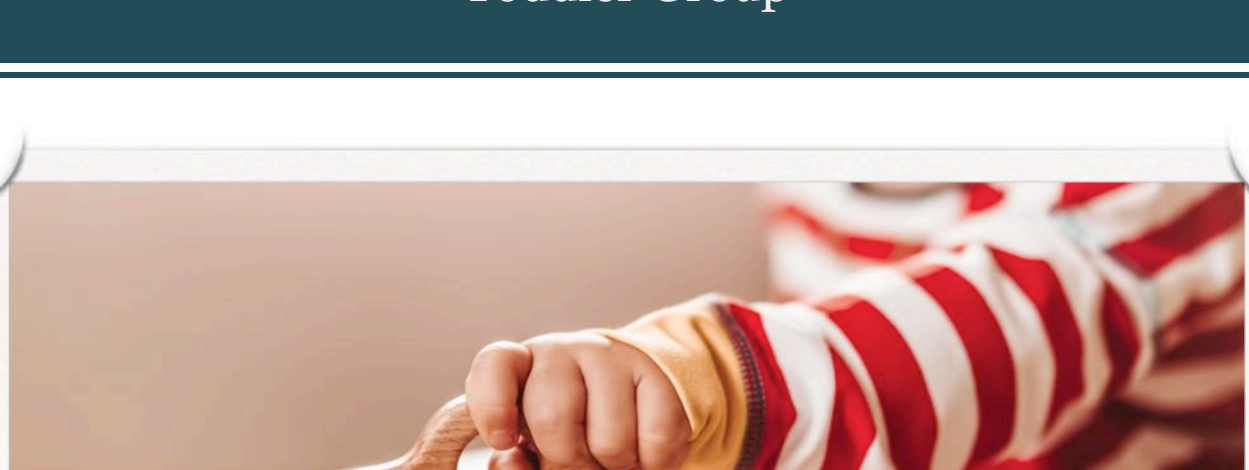


Special Celebrations

Toddler Group

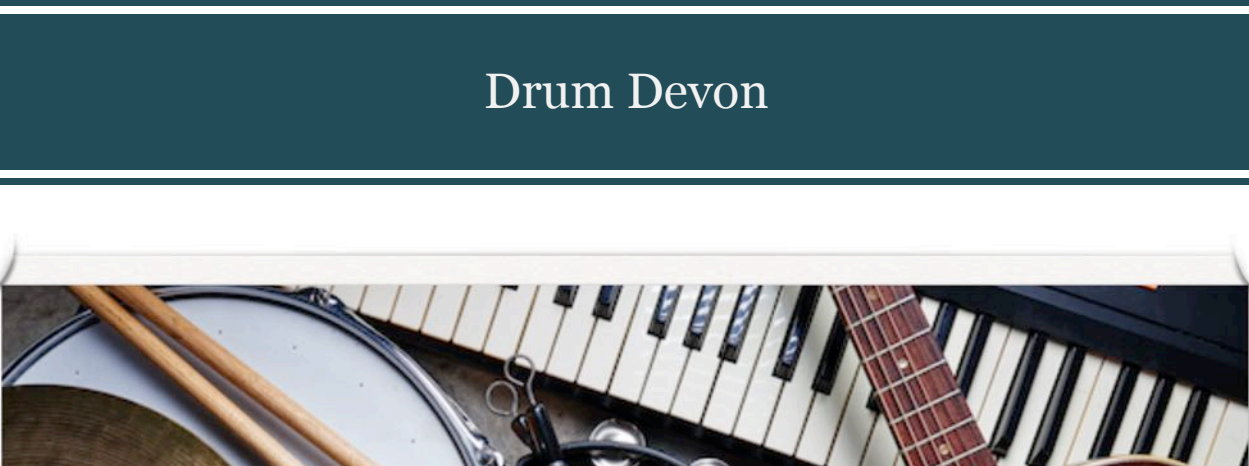


Intergenerational

Drum Devon

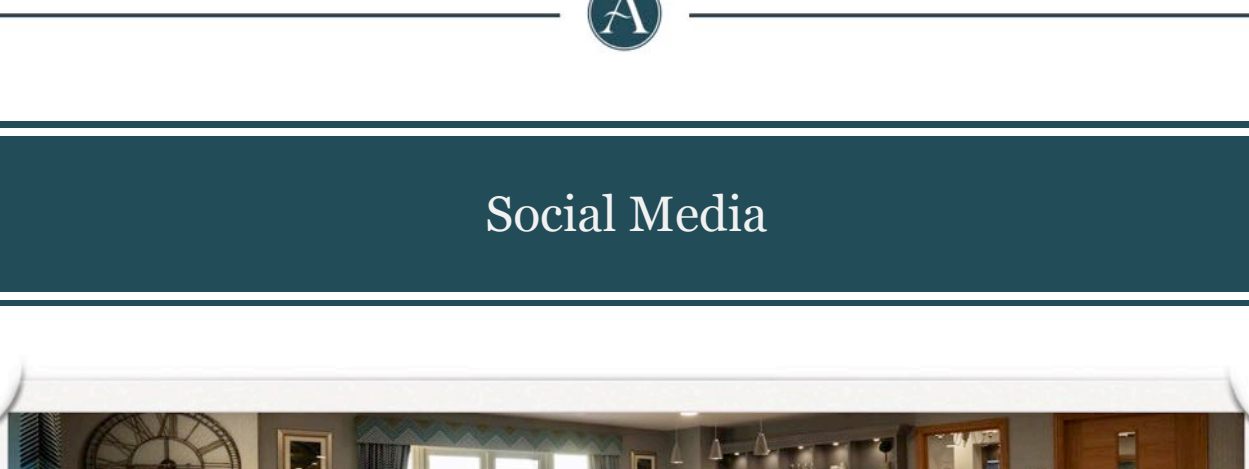


Good Times

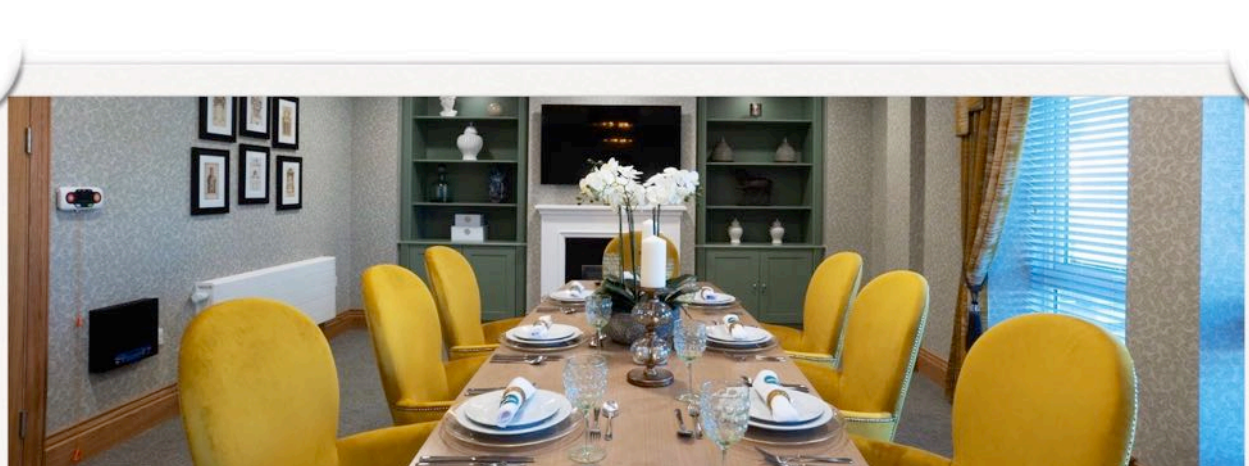
