

I hope you enjoy reading about some of the recent highlights and activities taking place around the home.






## ACTIVITIES & EVENTS



In the lead-up to Christmas, the home was busy with a range of themed games and activities. Two firm favourites were Christmas Bingo and festive flower arranging.




It was a meaningful and enjoyable service, giving residents the opportunity to reflect, sing together, and mark the season in a traditional way.
